Academics

Our curriculum is designed to prepare students for college and career, but more importantly for a life devoted to seeking the truth and acting in accordance with it. In partnership with parents, a faculty advisor meets regularly with and guides each student as he or she works on personal and academic growth. Extra time to facilitate interaction and collaboration between faculty and students is built into our schedule.

- 4 units: English, Math, History, Theology, Science
- 3 units: Foreign Language, Fine Arts
- 2 units: Physical Education; Academic electives
- 0.5 unit: Study skills, Service elective
